

Call for applications

**100 scholarships for students with international protection
to enroll in Bachelor, Master degree and PhD programs
in Italian Public Universities - A.Y. 2018/19**

Art. 1 - Aim

According to the Conference of Italian University Rectors (CRUI), in cooperation with ANDISU (National Association of Organizations for Right to study), following the Memorandum of Understanding signed in Rome on July 20th 2016, the Italian Ministry of Interior offers **100 scholarships for the A.Y. 2018/19 to refugee students or with international protection obtained by July 16th, 2018.**

The deadline to submit the application is July 29th, 2018.

The scholarships are awarded by the University, possibly in cooperation with the Regional Authorities for the Right to Study, and entitle students to the same treatment of the scholarship of the right to study holders, pursuant to article 4 c.4 of Legislative Decree 68/2012.

Art. 2 – Who can apply

The scholarships are reserved to students having the status of refugees or subsidiary protection belonging to the following categories:

- a) **Winners of the previous calls in the A.Y. 2016/17 and A.Y. 2017/2018** who are entitled to obtain the scholarship in A.Y. 2018/2019, if they obtain the minimum number of CFUs indicated in art.4.
- b) **Students who obtain a regular enrollment, for the first time in the Italian university system**, in a bachelor (corso di laurea triennale), master degree (corso di laurea magistrale), or a PhD program (corso di dottorato) - **A.Y. 2018/2019.**

For the enrollment to bachelor the Declaration on value of the high school diploma is required. The Declaration of value is not required, instead, for access to master degrees and PhD courses. For more information, visit the Ministry of Foreign Affairs website at:

Art. 3 – How to apply

Both categories of candidates must apply from the web site <http://borsespi.laziodisu.it>, by July 29, 2018, midnight, Rome local time, entering the following data:

1. Family name
2. First name
3. Gender
4. Date of birth
5. State of birth
6. Citizenship
7. Italian fiscal code (codice fiscale)
8. Certificate of international protection (number, date of issue, authority)
9. Residency permit (number, date of issue, *Questura* in charge)
10. Current refuge shelter (Welcoming place)
11. School/University degree
12. Year of issue
13. Institution where they achieved the degree
14. - Students referred to in art. 2, lett. a: Italian University where they are registered;
- Students referred to in art. 2, lett. b: Italian University where they want to register*:
15. First degree course, Second degree course, or PhD
16. e-mail
17. Mobile phone number

Applicants are also required to attach the following documents:

1. Copy of an **Italian identity document (ID)**;
2. Copy of the **document certifying the international protection**;
3. - Students referred to in art. 2, lett. a: **list of exams taken**;
- Students referred to in art. 2, lett. b: **short CV** (in Italian or English).

Art. 4 – Selection process

- a) **Student winners of the call A.Y. 2016/2017 (Article 2, letter a)**: confirm the scholarship for A.Y. 2018/2019 if they achieve at least 60 CFUs on 16/07/2018. The scholarship will be awarded after the 3rd year registration for A.Y. 2018/2019. In the PhD programs the number of CFUs is automatically satisfied.
- b) **Student winners of the call A.Y. 2017/2018 (Article 2, letter a)**: confirm the scholarship for A.Y. 2018/2019 if they achieve at least 15 CFU within 16/07/2018 with the commitment to achieve at least 20 CFUs within 10/08/2018. The scholarship will be awarded after the 2nd year registration for A.Y. 2018/2019 and verification of the minimum number of 20 CFUs on 10/08/2018. In the PhD programs the number of CFUs is automatically satisfied.
- c) **Students with international protection enrolling for the first time for A.Y. 2018/2019 (Article 2, letter b)**: a proper committee nominated by the President of the CRUI will define a ranking list, taking into account the title of study, the CV and the level of the degree chosen (PhD, Master Degree, Bachelor program respectively) for each candidate. For equally ranked candidates, priority will be given to the younger one.

The committee will complete the work by 31/07/2018. The ranking list containing the personal data of the winners and the chosen university, will be published by 03/08/2018 on the Ministry of Interior, CRUI and ANDISU websites.

Ministry of Interior will check all the candidates and the students do not have the status of refugee student or with subsidiary protection will be cancelled from the ranking list.

The scholarships will be awarded according to the ranking of eligible candidates, after students from the letters a) and b).

The scholarships will be awarded after the proper enrollment of the students to the bachelor, master or PhD programs for A.Y. 2018/2019.

Art. 5 - Incompatibility

The scholarship is incompatible with any other scholarship or grant supplied by Italian public organizations.

Art. 6 – How to get the scholarship for the A.Y. 2019/2020

To obtain the scholarship confirmation in the academic year 2019/2020, in case of available new resources:

- students enrolled in the first year in the A.Y. 2018/2019 will have to achieve at least 15 CFU on 16/07/2019 with the commitment to achieve at least 20 CFU on 10/08/2019;
- students enrolled in the second year in the A.Y. 2018/2019, enrolling in the III year in A.Y. 2019/20, will have to achieve at least 60 CFU on 16/07/2019.
