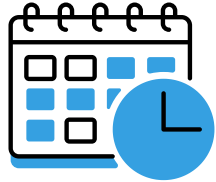

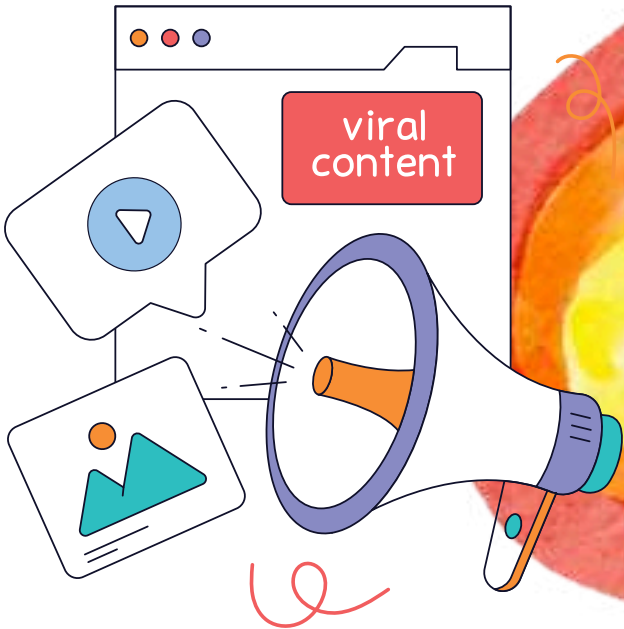

Welcome to AI in rAInbow community, an Erasmus+ KA152 Youth Exchange bringing together 40 young people and 8 group leaders from Germany, Türkiye, Greece, Romania, North Macedonia, Italy, Spain, and Bulgaria. 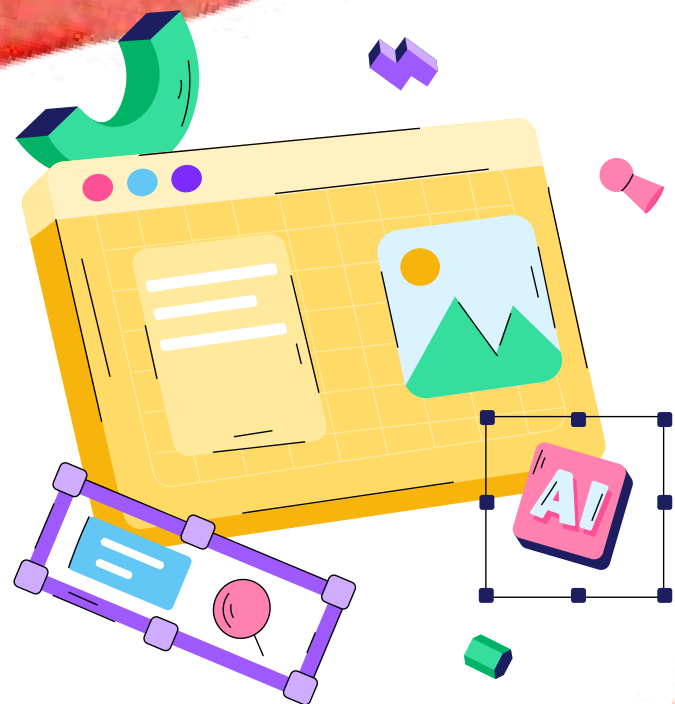

- Promote youth participation in Erasmus+ and EU initiatives.

- Digital storytelling labs & story circles for campaign creation.

- Inclusive AI hackathon for bias-free tech solutions.
- Arts & crafts, outdoor activities for creativity and well-being.
- Ongoing reflection & evaluation to track personal growth.

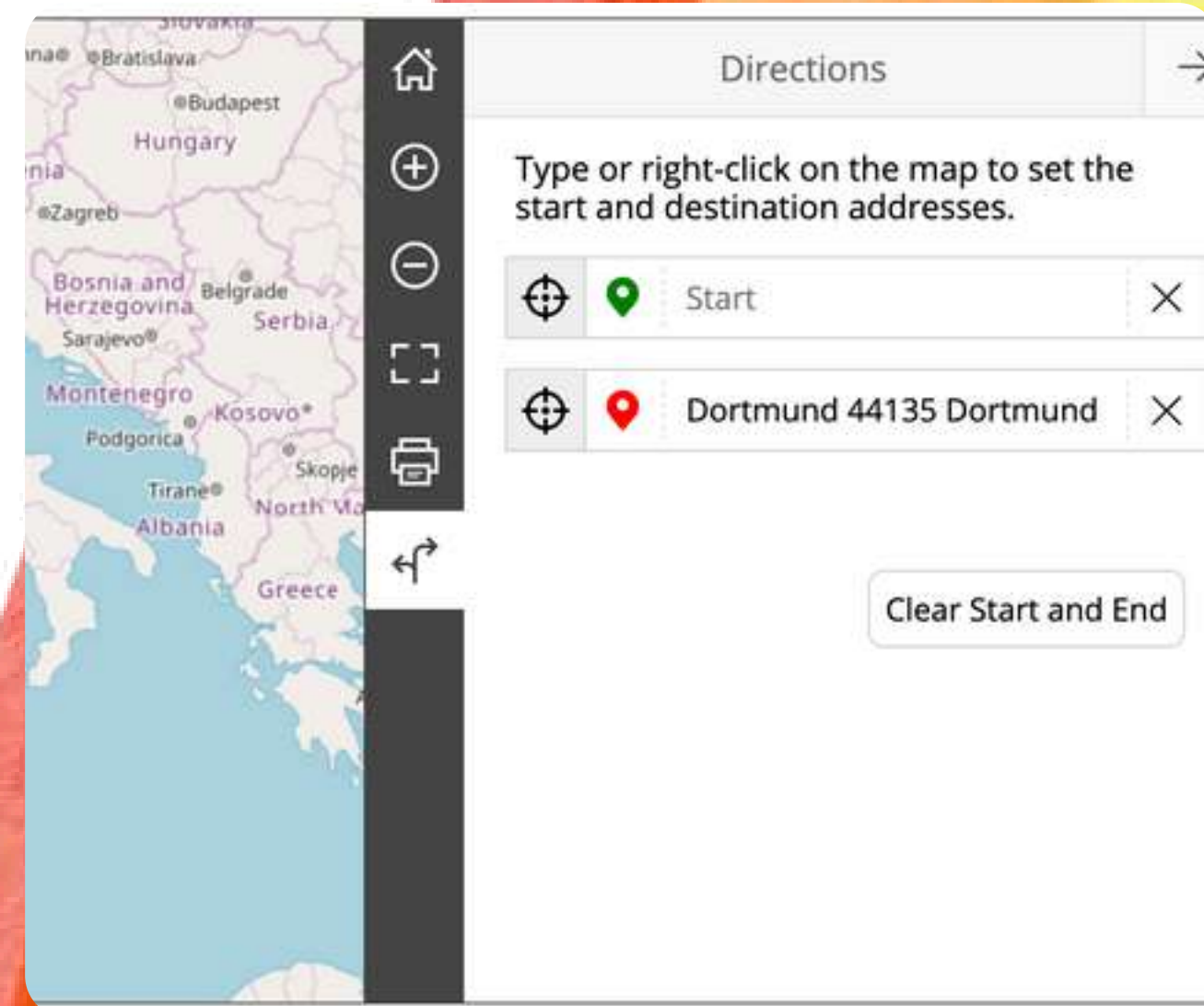

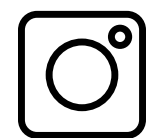
