

What is the Project About?



The "Migrapreneurs: Building Inclusive Enterprises" project is an Erasmus+ Youth Exchange initiative that focuses on empowering young migrants and marginalized youthby equipping them with entrepreneurial skills and fostering social inclusion through intercultural cooperation.

In essence, the project is about:

Helping young migrants become successful entrepreneurs and active citizens in their communities.

It is a two-step project. The first step will be implemented in Dortmund, Germany (will focus on learning entrepreneurship basics and develop business ideas.

The second step will be implemented in Přerov, Czechia (will focus on refining and pitching business plans, and network with startup professionals).



What are the Objectives?

1. Enhance entrepreneurial skills of migrant youth through practical, non-formal training.

2. Foster social inclusion and equity by encouraging intercultural dialogue and mutual understanding.

3. Enable development of actionable business plans with real-world application.

4. Promote cultural entrepreneurship by integrating heritage and identity into business ideas.

5. Build sustainable networks of youth, mentors, and organizations across Europe.

6. Improve soft skills and employability (e.g., leadership, communication, adaptability).

7. Encourage lifelong learning and a proactive growth mindset.

Expected Outcomes



- Actionable business plans
- Increased confidence and entrepreneurial mindset
- Enhanced employability through soft and digital skills
- Recognition through Youthpass
- Positive role models among migrant youth
- New business initiatives contributing to local economies
- Promotion of cultural diversity in enterprise

Who Will Participate?

There will be a total of 30 young participants. Each country will send 4 young individuals aged 18 to 30, along with 1 group leader, with no age restrictions.

Candidates from migrant backgrounds will be given priority to help fulfill the project's objectives.

While no previous experience in Erasmus+ is necessary, candidates must demonstrate a strong motivation to take part in the project.

A minimum of B1 level proficiency in English is required.



Project Activities


The Project is structured with the core elements of Erasmus+ Programme and non-formal learning activities. Formal education is not included in order to have maximum learning space and peer supported learning.




